POSITION OVERVIEW:

OUR CHOICE | NUESTRA OPCION DEMONSTRATION STUDY

Our Choice | Nuestra Opcion (OCNO) is a collaborative demonstration study between San Diego State University, Imperial County Public Health Department and Clinicas de Salud del Pueblo, Inc. OCNO is aimed at preventing and managing obesity in children from 2 to 10 years of age in Brawley, Calexico and El Centro. OCNO will need a Registered Dietitian to assess, monitor, and evaluate the nutrition of overweight and obese pediatric patients. The Registered Dietitian will conduct assessments and implement nutrition intervention plans, provide follow-up to track progress, consult with the Chronic Care Team members and the Patient Care Coordinator, as well as collect and report data. The Registered Dietitian will perform these services at clinic sites in the three targeted cities on a regular basis.

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Establish a rapport with Clinicas patients and their families to facilitate the participation in clinical care, wellness and other activities provided by the Our Choice study; assess and treat the nutritional status of study participants, as referred by the treating clinician, on an at least an annual basis; develop and implement a nutrition plan to affect change, and communicate the plan thoroughly to ensure the patient and family's understanding of the process and expectation; monitor patient progress and outcomes and report findings to referring clinician; communicate established demonstration project messages as appropriate and ensure that all nutrition education materials provided to participants are age and gender appropriate and language sensitive; and perform other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR THIS POSITION:

Must be a Registered Dietitian with the American Dietetic Association or be Registered Dietitian eligible. Must have experience in community health services, nutrition education, counseling, and intervention programs.
